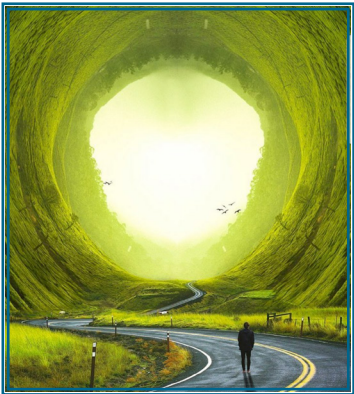
Further Light will meet regularly on Saturday Mornings throughout the fall. The format is that of Masonic Discussions related to moral issues.
